## SUBSCRIBED STALLION PROGRAM

This purse is paid to the Nominators of stallions when a stallion's offspring place as shown below in the NRCHA Stakes. A Nominator is the person who pays up a Stallion's offspring in the NRCHA Stallion Stakes for a specific foaling year.

A payment is made for a specific foaling year of a stallion's offspring making them eligible for the NRCHA Stakes and the NRCHA Yearling Sale Purse.

A person other than the owner of a stallion can be the nominator of a stallion if they have a notarized "Permission to Nominate" form signed by the stallion owner on file with the NRCHA.

These horses sold in the 2010 NRCHA Futurity Select 2 Year-Old Sale and are eligible to compete in the 2011 NRCHA Futurity for a guaranteed \$30,000 purse. Consignors of the NRCHA 2 Year-Old Sale Purse Incentive winners will receive \$1,500 for Open and \$500 for the Non Pro from the Select 2 Year-Old Sale Incentive Purse funds. After the Consignor purse is paid, the balance of the purse will be paid: 70% to the highest advancing eligible entry in the Open Futurity Preliminaries and 30% to the highest advancing eligible entry in the Non Pro Futurity Preliminaries.

## \$5,000 Added 2011 Yearling Sale Purse

For yearlings that are eligible for the NRCHA Stakes and actually sell to a new owner in the 2011 Select Yearling & Broodmare Sale or the 2011 Classic Yearling & Broodmare Sale. A nomination fee of \$250 will pay the yearling up for the Yearling Sale Purse. The \$250 payment may be paid by the consignor prior to the Sale or the buyer may pay after the purchase, however the payment must be made no later than October 2, 2011 (the last Sunday of the NRCHA Futurity). The Added money, plus the nomination fees, will be paid to the highest advancing eligible 3 year old in the 2013 NRCHA Open Futurity Preliminaries.



Each year Ward River Ranch donates the NRCHA Futurity Raffle Colt. Half of the raffle proceeds are used to sponsor the NRCHA 2 Year-Old Sale Purse. This money, plus \$150 from the entry fee of each NRCHA Select 2 Year-Old Sale entry are combined to make the NRCHA 2 Year-Old Sale Purse. NRCHA guarantees that the NRCHA 2 Year-Old Sale Purse will be at least \$30,000. **Only entries which sell and change ownership are eligible for the NRCHA 2 Year-Old Sale Purse.** Consignors of the NRCHA 2 Year-Old Sale Purse Incentive winners will receive \$1,500 for Open and \$500 for the Non Pro from the Select 2 Year-Old Sale Incentive Purse funds. After the Consignor purse is paid, the balance of the purse will be paid in the following manner: 70% to the highest advancing Select 2 Year-Old Sale entry in the NRCHA Open Futurity Preliminaries; 30% to the highest advancing Select 2 Year-Old Sale entry in the Non Pro Futurity Preliminaries. An entry that was repurchased and not sold will not be eligible for the Select 2 Year-Old Sale Purse.

# Bidder's Number & Payment

## Buyers **MUST** register for a Bidder's Number prior to bidding

To register you will need to present:

- 1) Picture identification such as a drivers license
- 2) Provide payment and Bank information
- 3) Buyers paying with Personal or Business Check that are NOT NRCHA members in good standing must provide a Letter of Introduction from their bank at time of registration.

**Accounts Must Be Paid** during or immediately following the end of each Sale Session, or contact Sale Office about payment.

**ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE PAID IN FULL** no later than 1 hour following the end of the Performance Horse Sale.

**All Payments shall be in U.S. CURRENCY** or checks drawn on U.S. Banks **ONLY**.

**Method of Payment** shall be Cash, Cashier's or Certified Check, Personal Check (with proper bank letter of guarantee or introduction and picture identification, such as driver's license), Traveler's Checks or MasterCard or Visa.

**NO Bank Drafts.**

**Credit Cards:** ONLY MasterCard and Visa will be accepted. ALL SALES FINAL.

**Buyer's Premium: 5%.** Buyer's Premium will be entirely discounted for purchases paid by cash or check.

**Registration Certificates** will be mailed to AQHA, or to buyers for other registries, approximately 21 DAYS after the sale for horses paid for by check and credit card.

**To obtain Registration Certificates on the day of the Sale,** payment **MUST** be made by CASH, CERTIFIED CHECK or MONEY ORDER.

**All "RETURNED CHECKS"** will be immediately turned over to the County District Attorney's Office for collection and charges. Cost of collection, including attorney's fees, will be assessed to the buyer. In addition, there is a \$50.00 charge for any returned checks.

## Attention Foreign Buyers

**Foreign Buyers** are required to pay in the manner specified below:

- 1) by US Currency, or
- 2) by a check drawn on a U.S. Bank, or
- 3) by world or international money orders.

**Foreign Credit Cards cannot be used** because of the difficulty getting approval due the large dollar amount and time difference. (Unless approved by the Sale Office prior to bidding.)

# Nevada Sales Tax

Nevada Sales Tax of 7.725% will be charged and added to the purchase price of all horses purchased except those with documented exemption claims.

In order to qualify for exemption from Nevada Sales Tax the buyer must sign a resale certificate and must also present to the auctioneer a copy of a sales tax permit or resale permit issued by the Nevada Department of Taxation (NDT) or their home state. This documentation is required to be copied and retained by the auctioneer / NRCHA, and must be valid as of the date of purchase. If the buyer's home state exempts the sale of horses from sales tax, then the buyer may qualify for exemption by completing an affidavit that the purchase is being made for resale in the normal course of business in their home state, and that their home state does not tax the sale of horses. To qualify for exemption at the time of settlement, this documentation must be presented before buyer settlement.

If specified documentation is not presented to the auctioneer before settlement of the Horse Sale, sales tax will be charged and must be paid. If valid documentation is received at the NRCHA Office no later than October 12, 2011, the buyer will qualify for consideration of exemption from Nevada Sales Tax and the NRCHA will issue a check for a refund of taxes paid.

# Multiple Embryos

**MULTIPLE EMBRYOS.** Since the American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) rule change allowing more than one foal (multiples) to be registered out of a mare in the same year, it is not possible for the AQHA, NRCHA, the Sale Company and/or the Sale Catalog Company to know how many live foals a mare has produced each year. Buyer hereby acknowledges that The National Reined Cow Horse Association, hereinafter referred to as "NRCHA", and Professional Auction Services, Inc. are not responsible for the warranties of the Consignor. Hereinafter, the NRCHA Sale Committee and Professional Auction Services, Inc., collectively, shall be referred to as "Sale Management".

**SECOND** - Horses are offered for sale according to the laws of the State of Nevada. Rights of consignors to bid are reserved unless otherwise announced.

**THIRD - THE BUYER HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO EXAMINE HORSES BEFORE BIDDING.** Horses entered in the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity Sales will be available for inspection. Bidders are encouraged to have a veterinarian perform a pre-purchase examination on any horse they may consider buying.

**FOURTH** - There is no warranty expressed or implied by NRCHA, Sale Management, Professional Auction Services, Inc., auctioneer, sponsors, owner or Consignor, as to the performing soundness, merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose of any horse offered in this sale, other than those made specifically by the consignor. In the event of resale the defaulting buyer agrees to pay all costs of resale and price deficiency, if any. Interest of 1-1/2% per month will be charged on the unpaid balance of any account not paid for as set forth in these conditions.

**EIGHTH - Bidding Procedure:** The person making the highest bid recognized by the Auctioneer shall be the buyer. The Auctioneer shall immediately present the buyer with a document entitled Acknowledgement of Purchase for signature. Should such presentation not be made prior to commencement of bidding on the next lot offered, the buyer shall forthwith identify himself/herself to auctioneer as buyer and sign Acknowledgement of Purchase.
